Morgan and his Grandparents began to raise awareness for FASD when he was 14 years of age and they've travelled extensively over the years. Morgan incorporates his Native American Flute playing into his programs to provide support for his message. He currently released three CDs (Ancestral Memories, Tears of Our Fathers, and Legacy). Morgan was inducted into the NOFAS Tom and Linda Daschle FASD Hall of Fame, selected as a Champion of Change for President Obama's Winning the Future Initiative, participated in the White House Internship Program as well as an Internship with Senator Mark Begich.
